In 2007 Loadtec were asked to supply and commission a multi-product Loading Terminal for a client in Nigeria. The scope supplied amounted to:

- 6 x Emco Wheaton World style top loading arms
- 6 x Carbis extra wide folding stairs with 4 metre long safety cages
- 6 x Electronic Metering skids
- A Terminal Control System
- Multi-tank gauging and alarm system
- 6 x high efficiency pumps



Loadtec provided design, procurement, project management, testing and certification to their client who is building a new terminal in the Delta region of Nigeria.

The client wanted to build a modern, efficient, and secure terminal which would provide reliable service in demanding conditions.

Loadtec sourced equipment from carefully selected suppliers and worked closely with them to ensure that all components would integrate and work without unnecessary site input and minimal commissioning times.

The need for pre-packaged and tested equipment is growing as clients establish fuel and chemical facilities in remote areas of the world. It is far quicker to build the systems in workshops in Europe and test it via simulation programmes. The packages arrive at site as “plug and play” solutions that only need simple feed wiring and liquid pipes via flanges. This gives the client great assurance of the quality and reduces the site time.
